Rules

- ❖ Registrations are open to Quebec residents, both members and non-members, and to all COURTEPOINTE QUÉBEC members living outside Quebec;
- ❖ Each individual or group can register a maximum of three (3) items in all categories (excluding the COURTEPOINTE QUÉBEC challenge);
- ❖ Each item must be equipped with a five (5) inch sleeve (see video on youtube);

- ❖ No rigid frames or other accessories (such as structure, equipment, string, etc.) will be accepted; however exhibitors entering items in category M must provide proper equipment for displaying said item(s).
- ❖ Once the registration is accepted, the exhibitor agrees that the item can be exhibited for the duration of the Salon, that it can be photographed and that the resulting images can be used for promotional, advertising, and pedagogical purposes, as well as to make a CD containing all of the items exhibited at the Salon;
- ❖ The Registrations Committee reserves the right to accept or refuse a registration based on the following considerations: the order in which the registrations arrive, the space available and the quality of the item;
- ❖ The Registrations Committee reserves the right to register an item in the appropriate category in case of an error at registration;
- ❖ The exhibitors may choose to have their quilt judged. All of the quilts are eligible for the “Public’s Choice”, but only judged quilts are eligible for the “Award of Excellence” (see the judges’ score sheet)

- ❖ The postmark or the date of the email will determine the order of the registrations. Any registration postmarked or email dated **before** April 16 and **after** May 21 will be automatically rejected.

Registration Modalities

- Each item presented must be registered on a separate registration form;
- Each item submitted must have been made by the individual or group indicated on the registration form;
- Each item must be accompanied by a brief description of the work, maximum 25 words, preferably in both languages (French and English);
- Each registered item must be accompanied by two (2) colour photos, printed or digital, for reference purposes only. If photos are sent by email, only one photo is needed;
- Each registered item (with or without the "For Sale" option) must be accompanied by a cheque payable to Courtepointe Québec or by an Interac E-Transfer to finance@courtepointequébec.com covering all of the registration and sale fees, as applicable; use "Courtepointe" as answer when requested for the etransfer.
- Exhibitors wishing to sell their item must indicate it on the registration form at a cost of \$5;
- Receipt of the registration form, accompanied by the photos and the payment, will be acknowledged;
- The exhibitor is responsible for the costs and procedures for sending and returning items (by mail or messenger) and must make the necessary arrangements and assume the costs;
- No registration fee will be reimbursed for items **withdrawn after May 21st, 2022.**

Categories

- A) **Bed quilt, hand quilted**
minimum size 36" × 48", maximum 110" × 110"
- B) **Bed quilt, quilted on a domestic machine**
minimum size 36" × 48", maximum 110" × 110"
- C) **Bed quilt, quilted on a long-arm machine**
minimum size 36" × 48", maximum 110" × 110"
- D) **Art quilt** – original non-commercial pattern; highlight on creativity and spontaneity
- E) **Wall quilt** – decorative piece intended to be suspended; perimeter of 96" or more
- F) **Miniature quilt** – miniature quilt proportional to a full-size quilt; perimeter maximum 96";
- G) **2020 Courtepointe Québec Challenge**
3Rs – (Reduce, Reuse, Recycle) Original pattern as much as possible; perimeter maximum 200";
- H) **Youth (open to those 17 and under)** – all sizes (no registration fee)
- I) **Modern Quilt** – piece with a modern aesthetic, using solid colors, high contrasts, negative space, minimalist design, alternative grids, improvised piecing, asymmetry;
maximum size 96" × 96"
- J) **Guild Quilt** – Original design, made entirely by several or all members of a guild; all techniques;
minimum size 36" × 48", maximum 96" × 96"
- K) **Textile Art** – artistic creation based on fabrics, using various mediums; the piece should be suspended; all general regulations herein must be respected; exceptionally, a false back is allowed for this category;
maximum size 96"×96"
- L) **Mystery quilts** - From the two mystery quilts made following CQ's 2021 and 2022 instructions
- M) **Wearable Arts** -Jacket, vest, coat or sets.
